

2009 National Activity Assessment for ANSI-Accredited Standards Developers

Effective January 1, 2005, an annual fee structure applicable to all ANSI-accredited standards developers (ASDs) replaced the BSR-9 processing fee and the cost of the separately billed periodic ANSI audits. The structure is based upon the number of American National Standards (ANS) sponsored by each developer on a graduated scale.

This administrative fee structure supports the infrastructure of the American National Standards (ANS) process. It also facilitates the budget planning processes of ANSI-Accredited Standards Developers by eliminating the extraordinary cost of a periodic mandatory audit. The fee structure is adjusted annually.

Extraordinary services, such as the conduct of a special audit for cause if required by the ANSI Executive Standards Council (ExSC), will be billed separately. ANSI-accredited standards developers will continue to be billed, as a separate item, for annual membership dues or the equivalent.
