## Biosurveillance

### What you will learn

During this 90-minute webinar, participants will explore the population perspective of health information sharing for natural and human-assisted events with local, regional and national import, gaining a basic knowledge of:

- syndromic surveillance through repurposing existing clinical information;
- detection of new patterns of disease as both a routine process and during emergency situations;
- situational awareness using repurposed clinical information to determine the extent and location of disease presentation as well as resource availability;
- expectations for information transfer from Electronic Health Records (EHRs) to biosurveillance information systems;
- the HITSP Interoperability Specifications for biosurveillance information sharing and their relationship to other efforts for public health and data repurposing.
